

Oroxylum indicum (Phanaphana)



Botanical Name	<i>Oroxylum indicum</i> (L) Vent. (BIGNONIACEAE)
Vernacular Name	Phanaphana, Shonyak
Description	Tree: bark light brown. Leaves - opposite, 2-3 pinnate, large, leaflets elliptic. Flower- large reddish in long terminal raceme. Fruit- capsule flat, woody, seed- flat, winged.
Regional Distribution	Through out Odisha
Global Distribution	India, Indochinese to Malesian region
Part Used	Root, stem, bark
Action & Uses	Anti-inflammatory, expectorant, carminative, anthelmintic, Anti-arthritis, useful in asthma and fever.
Folk Use	Colic pain, general weakness, tonsillitis, swelling, fever, joint pain
Threats	Hm, Lf, Tp.
