

Zanthoxylum rhetsa (Marua)



Botanical Name	<i>Zanthoxylum rhetsa</i> (Roxb.)(RUTACEAE)
Vernacular Name	Marua, Morei
Description	Leaves are compound, imparipinnate, alternate, spirally arranged, clustered at twig ends. Flowers are borne in panicles, at branch-ends or from uppermost leaf axils. Flowers are polygamous, greenish yellow; male and female flowers stalkless. Male flowers: sepals are 4, ovate-triangular.
