

Thalictrum foliolosum (Bharada)



Botanical Name	<i>Thalictrum foliolosum</i> (DC.)(RANUNUCULACEAE)
Vernacular Name	Bharada
Description	Leafy Meadow-Rue flowers are small, white to dull greenish-purple, many in much-branched often dense clusters borne on tall leafy stems 1.2-2.6 m. Petals are ovate, 3-5 mm, green, soon falling; stamens much longer, filaments white. Leaves are 15-45 cm, many times divided into oblong-ovate, rounded-toothed, 3-lobed leaflets 1-1.5 cm. Achenes are 2-5, ellipsoid, strongly ribbed, stalkless; beak curved.
Regional Distribution	Similipal, Mahendragiri, Niyamagiri, Malyagiri, Gandhamardan hills, Kapllash hills.
