

## *Schrebera swietenoides* (Eksira)



<b>Botanical Name</b>	<i>Schrebera swietenoides</i> (Roxb.) (OLEACEAE)
<b>Vernacular Name</b>	Ekasira, Ghanti
<b>Description</b>	Leaves are compound, imparipinnate, opposite, estipulate; rachis 5-10 cm, slender, pubescent flowers are bisexual, yellowish brown, fragrant, 1 cm in size, nocturnal, in terminal, trichotomous cymes. Stigma is shortly bifid. Fruit is a pendulous capsule, 5 x 2.5 cm, obovoid, loculicidally 2 valved. The seeds are winged. Capsule is the size of a hen's egg, and pear shaped.
