Description	Polyalthia species are trees or shrubs, erect or rarely scandent, dioecious. Leaves simple, alternate, glabrous or softly pubescent. Flowers bisexual, solitary or few, leaf opposed, axillary, supra-axillary, pubescent, pedicellate and bracteate.
