

Stemona tuberosa (Kelia Kanda)



Botanical Name	<i>Stemona tuberosa (Lour.) (ROXBURGIACEAE)</i>
Vernacular Name	Kelia kanda, Koila kanda
Description	Leaves opposite, rarely alternate. Stames very large, erect with stout red filaments, deeply grooved in front with crenulate margins, connective green, anthers linear, inner layer of cell produced in to a subulate point, pollen waxy to floury. Capsule ovoid-oblong, 3.7 cm long, 5-8 seeded.
Regional Distribution	Similipal, Mahendragiri, Koraput, Nayagarn, Berbera & Tamana forest (Khorda), Kalinga ghat (Kandhmal).
